Using Fraudstopper Bags to Protect High-Value Parcels

Step 1

Prepare two boxes. The smaller will go inside the larger. Print the shipping label twice. Put one label on the outside of the larger box and one on the outside of the smaller box. If the label is damaged on the outer box, the label on the inner box will identify the parcel destination.

Also, ALWAYS use labels that adhere directly to the box. NEVER use labels printed on loose paper and inserted into an adhesive sleeve. Loose labels can separate from the box. If you don't have adhesive labels, please print your label on standard paper and then TAPE it firmly to the box, covering the entire label and all its edges with clear tape.

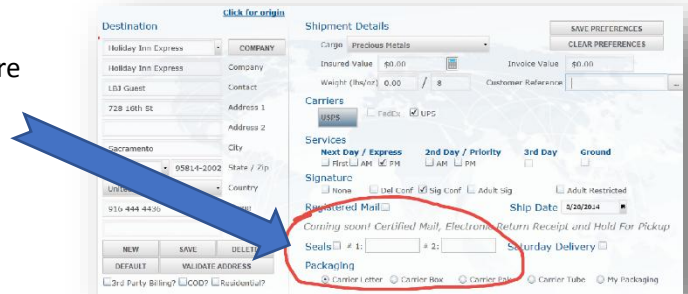


Step 2

Put your merchandise inside the smaller box and seal the smaller box shut. Put the smaller box inside the Fraudstopper and seal the Fraudstopper (instructions for doing this are printed on the Fraudstopper).



Retain the Fraudstopper seal number (on the tear-off adhesive strip) so that you will be able to type that number in the SEAL # Field in on the TransGuardian Shipping Software user interface.



Step 3

Place the small box (which is inside the sealed Fraudstopper) inside the larger box.



Step 4

Seal the larger, outside box. It looks like any other express box and is ready to ship.
